

The Program...

Our "Girls" division is intended for Middle School and High School age girls. This division is also open to adult women. The curriculum will focus on skating and will progress to puck control and passing skills. The pace of practice will be fast, however the tone will be slightly less intimidating.

Our "Girls Clinic" will skate on Sunday mornings at 10:30 AM at the Family Ice Center in Falmouth. The clinic will begin on Sunday April 27 and will skate for seven consecutive Sunday mornings through June 8. This clinic will follow our proven format of weekly two hour ice sessions, a one hour practice followed by a one hour controlled scrimmage.
